

NSFA & Northern Tigers FC has implemented Codes of Conduct for all its stakeholders

PARENTS PLEDGE

Please make yourself familiar with the code as it applies to you as a parent

- I will not use offensive language or harass players, coaches, match officials or spectators.
- I will not instruct/question players, match officials, coaches on match day.
- I will encourage my child to play within the rules and respect official and coaches' decisions.
- I will teach my child to respect the efforts of their teammates and opponents.
- I will encourage my child to discuss their development directly with the coach.
- I will follow all reasonable requests by the coaches or club officials.
- I will respect the rights, dignity and worth of every person regardless of their gender, ability and cultural background.
- I will not criticize or ridicule my child's or any player's performance during or after the game.
- I will not arrive at the field intoxicated/under the influence of drugs or drink alcohol/take drugs at matches or training.
- I will gain an understanding of, respect and abide by the club's policies and philosophy.
- I will not speak to the coach unsolicited regarding team/player performance.
- I will not enter the field of play or the changing room unless requested by a club official.
- I understand the Team Manager cannot respond to questions on football related matters.
- I will not engage in social media, forums, emails, blogs or other electronic media to comment on any aspect of NSFA/Northern Tigers or opposition clubs (includes teams, players, coaches, match officials, club officials, parents or spectators). Any such activity will be dealt with by the NSFA P.D & D.C committee consistent with the sanctions outlined in the current Football NSW Grievance and Disciplinary Regulations that relate to "Detrimental Public Comment."
- I will not engage in any behaviour that brings the Northern Tigers or the NSFA into disrepute. Such behaviour will be subject to an NSFA Board citing directly to the NSFA P.D & D.C committee. This committee will determine appropriate action, including sanctions, where required. The NSFA P.D & D.C committee will determine sanctions consistent with those outlined in the current years Football NSW Grievance and Disciplinary Regulations – "Table C: Other Offences By Members."
- I understand player and parent contact details are not to be used for any purpose other than operating and managing the team as required and approved by the Club.

I agree to abide by this code of conduct and to be subject to the rules and policies of the Northern Suburbs Football Association (NSFA) and Northern Tigers Football Club.

If I breach the above code of conduct, I understand NSFA/Northern Tigers FC may impose a penalty ranging from a written warning to immediate player de-registration.
